I. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Ms. Tracy Greever-Rice called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

II. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Mr. Cody Darr asked if the interim report had been finalized and Ms. Tracy Greever-Rice stated she did not get it included in the agenda but would circulate it via email and get it approved and out. Agenda was approved as written with a motion by Mr. Bill Weitkemper and a second from Ms. Kim Kraus.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The July 26, 2016 meeting minutes were approved as written with a motion by Mr. John Conway and a second by Mr. Cody Darr. Motion approved unanimously.

The August 2, 2016 meeting minutes were tabled pending amendments with a motion by Mr. Cody Darr and a second by Mr. John Conway. Motion approved unanimously.

IV. OLD BUSINESS

1) Discuss downtown area electric utility issues and recommendations

Mr. John Conway spoke about the Mill Creek substation and wants to recommend to Council that it be built as originally designed and be funded with enterprise revenue and/or capital improvement program reserves and extend the Administrative Delay. Ms. Tracy Greever-Rice suggested splitting Mr. Conway's recommendations into three separate recommendations, to which Mr. Conway agreed. Bill Weitkemper mentioned Option E and Katrina Boles asked if Option E was a viable option and after some discussion between the members, Ryan Williams spoke in detail about the transmission lines project and substations and the differences between Option A and Option E and what is in the works at the moment. Some members wanted to delete the third sentence about "Administrative Delay"; Ms. Greever-Rice suggested instead changing it to reflect that some members wanted to strike it while other wanted to leave it for Council to decide. Mr. Conway concluded that he needed to work on the third sentence.

The members discussed Bill Weitkemper's electric recommendations.

2) Discussion of scheduling for September and October 2016
